### **Matthew 26:28**

### **Colossians 1:20**

. . . and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross.

### **Hebrews 9:14**

. . . how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

### **I Peter 1:18-19**

. . . knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things like silver and gold from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.

### **I John 1:7**

. . . but if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

Why we meet here this morning is to remember our hero Jesus shed His blood and He died, but arose from the dead. So now we have the hope of eternal life.
