Hebrews 6:10

How we remember Him

Isaiah 26:8

Yes, in the way of your judgements, O Lord, we have waited for You; the desire of our soul is for Your name and for the remembrance of You.

And, to remind each other

2 Peter 3:1

Beloved, I now write to you this second epistle (in both of which I stir up your pure minds by way of reminder).

We do forget so easily that we need to be reminded from time to time

That is why we are here this morning, so as not to forget what was done for us through Jesus Christ; Because Jesus payed for our sins.

Romans 5:8-9
