### Micah 6:6-8

Will the Lord be pleased with thousands of rams, ten thousand rivers of oil? Shall I give my firstborn for my transgression, the fruit of my body for the sin of my soul? He has shown you, O man, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justly, to love mercy, and walk humbly with your God?

That is why Jesus came into the world knowing we could not accomplish these requirements from God.

### Matthew 20:28

... just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.

### Philippians 2:8

And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.

While we could not humble our arrogant selves, Jesus showed us the way by humbling Himself for us.
