

LORD'S SUPPER EXHORTATION

This is a day of remembrance: A day of remembering Jesus and His suffering, death and resurrection, but also of ourselves. As Christians in Corinth were taking each other to court, Paul had to remind them of what they used to be.

1 Corinthians 6:9-11

Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the Kingdom of God?

Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortionists will inherit the Kingdom of God. And such were some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.

I don't have any idea if any here fit in these last verses, but that is not the point. The point is that we were all guilty of committing sin in flesh of some kind.

As we remember Jesus' death and resurrection, take a moment to also remember...

1 Corinthians 11:28-29

But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of the bread and drink of the cup. For he who eats and drinks in an unworthy manner, eats and drinks judgment to himself, not discerning the Lord's body.

Lest we forget it is ONLY because of Jesus that we have been forgiven and are now homeward bound.
